Capacity

4,950 total – festival style

Loading Dock

There is a 132' ramp, with a 6-degree grade in the first 100', just south of Third Place on Centennial Way. Trucks must back down the ramp, which accommodates one truck at a time. The dock height is 36 inches with an adjustable leveling plate. Load in is through a 10' x 10' overhead door on the right side of the dock. The largest door onto the stage is 6'11" high by 5'8" wide. No vehicle may remain in the loading dock during the show.

Parking

Parking is available for cars and buses behind the stage. This area is inside the security fence. Truck parking is on Third Place directly behind the Amphitheatre complex.

Stage Dimensions

Maximum width - 60' at proscenium
26' at upstage wall
Performance depth - 44' at center
34' at sides
Ceiling height - 32' at proscenium
24' at upstage wall
Height from ground (house) to stage floor is 4'

Power

Sound: 200 amps, 3 phase, 100 amps, 3 phase isolated: stage right
Lights: 600 amps, 3 phase: stage left
Shore Power: (1) 50-amp service: backstage,
requires show supplied cables at least 100' in length

Rigging

Rigging is accomplished from the structural roof grid above the stage ceiling.

Access is through a series of hinged panels that swing down.

Distributed load capacity of 19,600 lbs.

There are no house draperies or battens.

Sound Wings

The sidewalks going off stage right and stage left into the house are used as sound wings. It is a house rule that enough depth (at least 18") be left clear behind the sound stacks on each side for security access.

Spotlights

There are three followspot positions, each wired for 1 light.

Throw distance to downstage center is 175'.

Mix Position

There is a 12' x 24' fenced mix position just in front of the first tier, house center. When using this position, it is required that the show snakes (audio, lighting and power) be routed along the walkways on either side of the house. **The distance from downstage right to the center position is 200'**. No cables are permitted in seating or aisles.

Backstage

There are two dressing rooms available equipped with make-up counters/mirrors and restrooms. One dressing room is also equipped with a shower. One room may be used as a production office.

Three phone lines are available; two of them are direct lines.

A dining/production area to accommodate 20 people is located adjacent to the dressing rooms.

Additional space is available in other areas of the complex if needed. (Additional charges apply.)

Decibel Limit

Due to City of Mesa restrictions, sound level must be kept below 100 DBA at the mix position. The facility uses a sound pressure level meter to determine the decibel level. The City does levy a \$2,500 fee per violation, and the event may be terminated at any time if this regulation is not adhered to.

Curfew

The City of Mesa curfew for noise is 10:00 pm. **All amplified sound must be concluded by 10:00 pm.**

Pyrotechnics

Four working weeks are required to obtain permission from the Fire Marshall to utilize stage pyrotechnics. Pyro-technician must be licensed in the state of Arizona. Please call the Mesa Fire Prevention Inspector at (480) 644-2636 for more information.
